- Motion 050623-1: Guideline change for PR Subcommittee READS—Article XIV Number 8 to add: "All new homegroups will be on a 3-month probation period, requiring the attendance to 3 consecutive ASCs before the web coordinator will add the group to the attendance to 3 consecutive ASCs before the web coordinator will add the group to the World and Regions website. This does not include the area meeting schedules or the Area Website. \*Passed Unanimously\*.
- Fliers from Regions: Not able to read information to functions or conventions. Requested the RCM to address at upcoming Regions.
